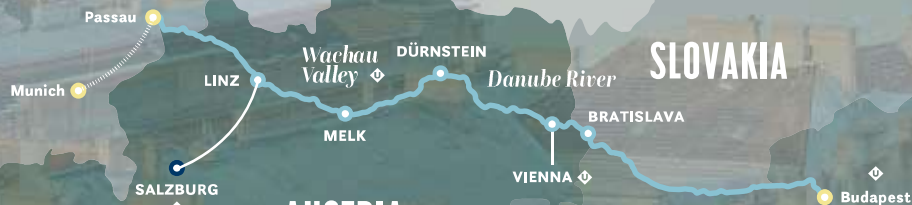

DAY 1: BUDAPEST (EMBARK) **D**

Arrive at Budapest Ferenc Liszt International Airport. If your cruise package includes a group arrival transfer or if you have purchased a private transfer, you will be greeted by a Uniworld representative and transferred to the ship.

DAY 6: LINZ (SALZBURG OR LINZ)

  **BB L D**

Mozart's birthplace of Salzburg is nestled in a glorious alpine setting that sparkles like a winter wonderland; Linz may be best known for its famous Linzer torte, but it's also a hotbed for the arts. See the sights with a local expert, or go behind the scenes at the Linz opera house and visit a family at their farm in the countryside. Austria's third-largest city, Linz boasts a long history of trading and textile manufacturing, but these days it is perhaps best known for its electronic arts and annual festival.

DAY 7: PASSAU **BB L FD**

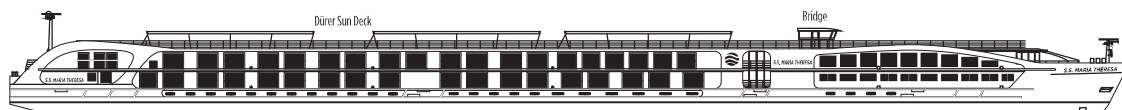
AN EXQUISITE CASTLE on water.

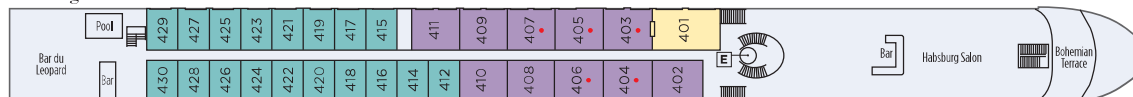

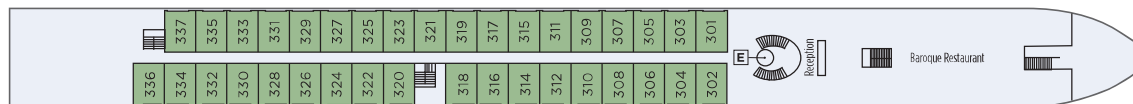


Hofburg Deck

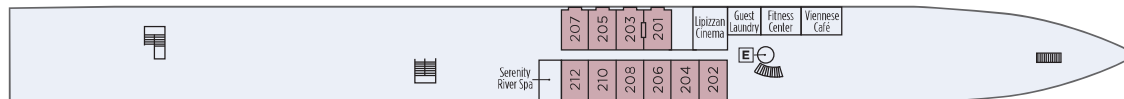
